

MEASURING GUIDE

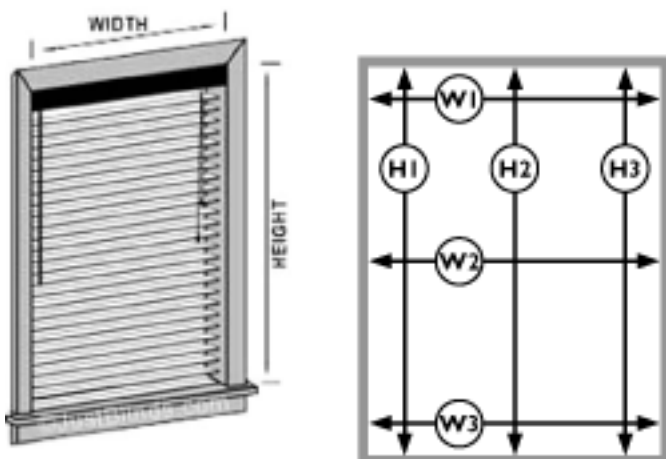
2 - DAY BLINDS.com

General Information:

- Use a steel measuring tape and measure, rounding to the nearest 1/8"
- Don't be surprised if your windows aren't perfectly square.
- Measure all windows, even if they appear to be the same size.
- Decide if you want your blinds installed within the window opening (Inside Mount) or on your wall/trim (Outside Mount). Most people use an Inside Mount for a neater look, but make sure you have enough depth to allow the product to fit. Use an Outside Mount when your opening is too shallow or when your window is significantly out of square.



INSIDE MOUNT



Width:

- 1) Measure the width of the window opening in 3 places (top, middle and bottom - See W1, W2 & W3 above).
- 2) Take the smallest of the 3 measurements (rounded down to the nearest 1/8 inch). Note: If top measurement is not the smallest, please also include your valance size.

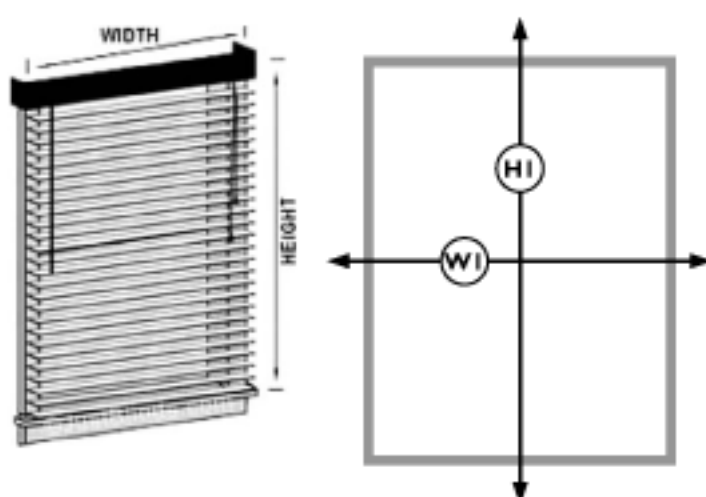
This is the width you will order. Do not make any deductions! The factory will make a small deduction from each side to allow room for the mounting brackets and/or to provide space for operation.

Height:

- 1) Measure the window opening height in 3 places (left, middle & right - See H1, H2 & H3 above).
- 2) This time, take the tallest measurement (except for vertical blinds and shangri-la shades, where you'll take the shortest measurement).

This is the height you will order. The factory will make no deductions or additions to your measurement.

OUTSIDE MOUNT



Width:

- 1) Measure the width of the window opening from left to right.
- 2) Add an extra 4-6 inches for maximum light gap coverage and privacy, if desired (W1).

This is the width you will order and the size that your product will be made. The factory will make no deductions or additions to your measurement for Outside Mount blinds.

Height:

- 1) Determine the height of the window opening by measuring from top to bottom
- 2) Add 3-6 inches to measurement to allow space for mounting brackets above the opening. Optionally, add a few extra inches so there is enough overlap at the bottom to avoid a light gap. (H1)

This is the height you will order and the size your product will be made. The factory will make no deductions or additions to your height measurement.

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
